NOTICE OF RACE**

1. RULES - The regatta will be governed by rules as defined by the United States Sailing Association in The Racing Rules of Sailing.
2. ADVERTISING – Advertising will be restricted to Category A
3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY – The invitational regatta is open to all Flying Scot boats.
4. REGISTRATION – Completed entry forms must be received by July 20, 2007 or be subject to a \$15 late fee. A registration form is included with this Notice. Send forms to : Joseph McCloskey, 27 Hart St. Oswego NY, 13126
5. FEES: The entry fee is \$75 if received by July 20, 2007, Entries received after that date must include a \$15 late-fee. The entry fee includes beverage tickets, 2 breakfasts and 2 lunches on Saturday & Sunday, and 2 Dinners on Saturday. Additional Social tickets may be purchased for \$25.

7. MEASUREMENT – Boats and sails must conform to the Official Plan. Each boat must carry equipment required by FSSA Article S-V.2 Restrictions and Coast Guard safety Regulations.

8. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS – Sailing Instructions will be available at registration and at the Skipper's meeting.

9. VENUE – Racing location will be determined on the day of racing. We will attempt to hold all races in the open water of Lake Ontario.

10. SCORING – The Low-point Scoring System of Appendix A2 will apply. Five races are scheduled, of which one shall be completed to constitute a series. Each boat's total score will be the sum for all races (no throw-outs).

11. PRIZES – The New York Lakes District Trophy will be won by a NY Lakes District and FSSA member. Prizes will be awarded to the top three boats.
